

Many of you may recall that this past November, the actual porch of The Back Porch was demolished for construction. The porch had, for over a year, been pulling away from the building, and falling off the original 110 year old house. Although seemingly slow in these long winter months, construction has been persistent and steady. Now that the weather is warming up, we pray the process is speedy! We now have the floor insulated, as well as all of the walls installed. It's happening!

This new porch is not only necessary for the physical upkeep of the building, but vital for welcoming women of all walks into the light -









- of Christ. We seek to create a welcoming and secure environment so that women will feel safe and loved, especially when their situation is dark and desperate.

The winter in Calgary has also seen some structural improvements. Although the 'porch' is a lot smaller for Life House, it was in need of repair too! Thanks to the speedy work of our pro-life community, the stairs to the front of the house are now brand new. We are pleased to provide an all-new hospitable environment for our growing community in YYC, and plan to build on that community for the women and men seeking abortion once we obtain the house right next door (still scheduled for late 2025).

You might think that clients would be deterred from coming to The Back Porch (instead of the clinic) because of construction. Truth be told, the number of women who knock on our door has dipped somewhat during construction, but women continue to come to our front door.

Her walk seemed slow and pained, and as soon as she spoke, she shyly

shared, "I am really embarrassed to share this...but..." As we invited her in, she began to describe her situation. Tanya was just dropped off at her abortion appointment across the street, yet did not wish to have an abortion. She was there under the influence of a physically abusive partner, who continually mistreated and isolated her. Being new to Canada, Tanya had no family here, nor support to help her with continuing her pregnancy. After our conversation, Tanya chose not to go to her abortion appointment. We were ready to help her undertake the complications of finding safe housing, support with legal help, continual assistance with the pregnancy, and anything else that might cross her path.

Amid the stress of leaving an abusive relationship, unfortunately Tanya suffered the loss of her child via miscarriage. We admire her courage for choosing to save her child from abortion, and hope to be there for any and every woman who may find themselves in a difficult situation, especially ones like hers. Praise God that he is able to reach women like Tanya in their eleventh hour.


